Purpose of Role

To drive traction units in a safe, punctual and economical manner in accordance with the rules and regulations currently in place

Principle Accountabilities

1. Ensure your personal safety and that of others at all times. Maintain a safe and tidy working environment
2. Comply with all relevant rules, procedures and policies. Undergo competence/proficiency assessments as required by company procedures and the Safety Management System (SMS).
3. Maintain currency of route or traction knowledge and notify line manager immediately of any route or traction knowledge shortfalls
4. Prepare, drive and dispose of traction units safely and as set out by the relevant instructions. Identify, locate and where necessary rectify or suitably tend to train and traction unit faults. Follow the correct fault reporting procedures.
5. Ensure having received and understood any notices, bulletins or other information relating to job and where required confirm receipt these in the prescribed manner. Maintain currency of all personal publications and equipment
6. Communicate effectively with and assist staff and customers in the interests of safety and customer service
7. Wear uniform and safety clothing provided
